Summary of ALTERNATIVE'25 - Sustainable Greater Bengaluru Survey Findings



The Greater Bengaluru Survey was done to understand Bengaluru citizen's perspective of the Greater Bengaluru Bill and what is their vision of clean Bengaluru. The focus of the survey was done with people who are staying in Bengaluru.

- 1. Profile of the people who participated in an online survey over a period of one month.
 - 80% of respondents were working professionals.
 - Representation from both genders were equal
 - 77% of respondents were under the age of 25
- 2. Voluntary work and participation in the civic work
 - Almost 50% of the youth who answered that they participate in some kind voluntary work and are happy to participate with Govt
 - Another 15% said that they would like to get involved in future

This is a great insight that the 65% of youth of Bengaluru want to get involved in the process of making Bengaluru a clean city

- 3. On Greater Bengaluru Bill
 - 40% were aware and somewhat knowledgeable about the GBA bAill
 - 30% had heard about the GBA Bill
 - 30% had not heard of the GBA Bill
 - 53% of responds knew that the Chief Minster was the chairperson of the GBA bill

Almost 70% of young audience are aware of Greater Bengaluru Bill

- 4. Impact of the GBA Bill
 - 64% respondents were positive that a central authority will improve the governance of Bengaluru city & will help in coordination & citywide planning
 - 67% felt that local governance at a ward level will empower the citizens
 - 57% felt that the cost of living will go up but it will help them have a better life

Almost 70% of young audience feel that Greater Bengaluru Bill will have a positive impact on Bengaluru
